ILLNESS POLICY

To protect your child, the staff, and the other children in the Treehouse, we request that you do not bring your children to the Treehouse if they are experiencing any of the following symptoms:

- Sluggishness or unusual drowsiness (*i.e. unable to participate in normal activities*)
- Extreme irritability or crying (*inconsolable*)
- Difficulty breathing, significant respiratory distress (*i.e. bad cough*)
- Diarrhea or loose stool within the last 24 hours
- Vomiting within the last 24 hours
- Unexplained rash
- Temperature of 100 degrees or more
- Conjunctivitis (*pink eye*)
- Profusely runny nose (*especially if not clear*)
- Has a bacterial infection and has not been on antibiotics for at least 24 hours
- Has lice, ringworm or scabies that is untreated and contagious
- Requires more care than the Staff can provide without compromising the safety of the other children in our care

If your child is too ill to attend school, they should not be brought to the Treehouse. To contain illnesses we ask that parents cooperate with our illness policy so that we can meet the needs of all the Treehouse participants.

Liberty Athletic Club reserves the right to refuse admittance to the Treehouse Activity Center if your child is ill.

WELCOME TO THE TREEHOUSE

To ensure the safety, well-being and overall enjoyment of the children who visit the Treehouse Activity Center, we ask that all members who utilize this service observe the following very important policies.

Treehouse Use

The Treehouse Activity Center is available for all children included on a membership. We are unable to accommodate guests at this time.

Appointments Required

Children ages 6 months up to 8 years of age require an appointment to use the Treehouse. Childcare reservations are available for up to 1-1/2 hour appointments.

Scheduling a Treehouse Appointment

Reservations may be made via the online member portal (liberty.clubautomation.com) or by calling the front desk at 734.665.3738 ext. 110. Reservations cannot be made via the Mobile App at this time.

How to Make a Reservation

Member Portal/Online Services

- Make childcare reservations on the "Childcare Reservation" tab/page
- Reservations may be made up to two days in advance
- You can cancel your reservation on the web portal

Childcare Entrance

Only Liberty membership scan tags will offer access to the Treehouse directly from the parking lot. All others must enter via the main entrance of the club.

Check-In

If entering from the parking lot, all members including adults accompanying children must also check-in and scan their membership tag at the Treehouse welcome desk. Scanning at the outdoor entrance gains you entrance, but does not check you in.

Parent On-Site

ALL CHILDREN using the Treehouse are required to have their parent or legal guardian on-site during their Treehouse stay.

Please Adhere to the Following:

Diapers & Wipes

Please bring a diaper and wipes from home for those children who are not potty trained.

Water Only

The Treehouse is a WATER ONLY facility. We ask that any bottles or sippy cups contain water only to protect against allergies.

Socks Only

A "shoes off, socks on at all times" policy is enforced for reasons of sanitation. You may purchase socks from the front desk if needed. Coats and jackets may be hung in the hallway, and shoes placed in the cubbies outside the Treehouse entrance.

Food & Toys

Please NO food, candy, gum or toys from home.

Electronics

Children under the Treehouse care are not allowed to bring electronic devices for use in the Treehouse. (i.e. Kindle, iPad, iPod, video game systems)

Treehouse Play Areas

For security purposes, we ask that parents refrain from entering into the Treehouse play area, beyond the second half-door. The Treehouse has video cameras positioned in each of the play rooms, which can be monitored by Liberty Management.

Front Room

The front room of the Treehouse is for children ages 6 months through 3 years.

Middle Room

Those aged 4 through 8 years may utilize the middle and back rooms, given they meet the back room usage requirements.

Back Room

To ensure the safety, well-being and overall enjoyment of the children who visit the Treehouse Activity Center, all children must meet the criteria listed below to play in the back room.

Children MUST:

- be AT LEAST 4 years old
- be verbal and communicative
- be well potty-trained
- be able to quickly separate from parents

While we are happy to help your child adjust to the back room, we may not be able to accommodate this during busy Treehouse hours. Given the room dynamics, the Treehouse staff reserves the right to determine the most appropriate room for your child(ren).

Failure to abide by these policies and procedures may result in suspension of Treehouse privileges.
